Private Lessons

Knit Clinic

Demonstrations

Every **1st Thursday** of the month, **6pm - 7pm**, we will focus on a new topic, such as steeking, cabling, blocking, cast-ons and -offs, shaping, and more. You're invited to come by to learn.

Kitcheners Stitch (Sept. 4th)

One of the joys of Kitcheners Stitch is the rhythm. Once you get the hang of it, that is. Stop by and we'll show you how to finally seam up those sock toes, underarms, and shoulder seams. One of the best forms of seaming, KS is very versatile and looks great.

Making stitch markers (Oct. 2nd)

Our knitter friend, Angie Gonzalez, will be by to show us all how to make stitch markers. This will be a wonderful demonstration! Everyone wants pretty markers in addition to those plain ones we all have. At least I do! Call us for more info.

Short Rows (Nov. 6th)

Short rows are often incorporated into a piece for additional length such as along the backs of a sweater or blouse and for ruffles in skirts or scarves. You'll also find them very useful in garment designs.

Buttonholes (Dec. 4th)

You won't believe how easy these are to make. Take out a few stitches here, add a few stitches there. Come by and we'll show you how to make the buttonholes *and* how to make them look alright.

Classes (Fall & Winter 2008)

Knit 101 • Beginner's Level (K101)

Tuition: \$20

In this 2-hr session, you will learn the basics skills of knitting as well as casting on and binding off. In addition, we offer a free follow-up support session to help with problems, answer questions, and make sure you're firm on your feet. *Supplies:* worsted weight yarn and US size 8 or 9 needles

Hats (Hats)

Reversible Brioche Hat (BRIO)

Tuition: \$20

Brioche ribbing, also considered prime rib(bing), is a form of ribbing that has amazing elasticity. Learn not only how to work this stitch but also how to do it in the round. Instructor and shop owner, Thi Miller, has figured out a way to make this two-colored hat reversible. Come and learn! *Supplies:* yarn and appropriate sized 16" circular & dpn needles

Mittens (Mitt)

Lace • Seascape Shawl (LAC)

Tuition: \$60

Lace is one of the most beautiful results of knitting. Consisting of strategically placed increases and decreases, lace takes on many forms of identity, from Gossamer styles to heirloom Shetland knits to the classic pi shawl. A bit of a challenge, but completely worth the effort. In this lesson, try the Seascape, a great beginners' shawl pattern. *Supplies:* Kidsilk Haze (3 balls) and US 4 needles

Socks (Sks)

Tuition: \$60

Knitting socks is quick, fun, and portable. With so many gorgeous sock yarns and stitch patterns, the options are limitless. This class is offered in 3 two-hour sessions. *Supplies:* sock or worsted weight yarn and appropriately sized needles

Colorwork 1 • Beginners (Col1)

A Latvian-inspired hat will be perfect for a beginner's colorwork piece. Sample will be available at the shop. In this two-session class, learn how to hold the

strands, establish correct tension with each color, and read and knit from color charts. *Supplies:* US 3 or 4 16" circulars & dpn needles, Jamieson Shetland DK in various colors
