Invisible Cast-On (Oct. 1st)

The invisible cast-on is one of the more commonly used techniques of casting on. Its versatility allows the knitter to use it for most garments and sometimes is actually preferred. This technique is actually quite easy to learn and a bit of a joy to do.

Buttonholes (Nov. 5th)

Need a buttonhole to go with that button? Stop by and we'll show you how to make one. Unbelievably easy and always useful.

Knit 101 • Beginner's Level (K101)

Tuition: \$20
