



Knitty Couture

Patterns

Three Fish Tic Tac Toe

Materials:

Yarn: 220 yds of worsted weight yarn + waste yarn for fish

Needles: US 6 knitting needles

US 6 double-pointed needles

Size G crochet hook

Stitch markers

Large tapestry needle

Gauge: 20-22 stitches per 4 inches

Abbreviations:

K Knit

K2tog Knit two stitches together

P Purl

M1 Make one increase stitch

PM Place marker

Ssk slip, slip, knit

Instructions:

Game Board

Cast on 60 sts. Note: Always slip first stitch.

Edging:

Knit 9 rows.

Row 10 & all even rows: k5, p50, k5

Row 11 & all odd rows: knit

Work until piece measures 3" from cast-on

Body:

Row 1 (RS) and all odd rows to row 15: knit

Row 2 (WS) and all even rows to row 14: k5, p17, k2, p12, k2, p17, k5

Rows 16 & 18: k5, p5, k40, p5, k5

Row 17: knit

Row 19–36: repeat rows 1-18

Rows 37–50: repeat rows 1-14

Edging:

Row 43: knit

Row 44: k5, p50, k5

Repeat these two rows 8x

Knit next 8 rows

Bind off in purl



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Patterns

Three Fish Tic Tac Toe cont.

Fish (make 6 per color)

Cast on 2 stitches

Row 1: knit

Row 2: k1, m1, knit to end

Repeat these two rows to 6 sts. knit 4 rows.

Row 12: k1, ssk, k2tog, k1

Row 13: knit

Row 14: ssk, k2tog

Row 15: knit

Row 16: k1, m1 twice, k1

Row 17: k1, m1, k2, m1, k1

Row 18: k1, m1, k4, m1, k1

Bind off in purl

Edging

The board will have a right-side and left-side edge.

1st Edge: Beginning on short side of the board and at the right edge of the left square, *single crochet into next three sts, CH2, skip next two sts (skip only one st for long sides of board)*. Double crochet into corner sts.

Repeat ** to left edge of right bottom square.

2nd Edge: Repeat 1st edging on second side of board.

I-Cord

Using two double-pointed needles, cast on 3 stitches. Work cord until piece measures 50". Weave cord into edging slots and seam the cord ends together.

Finishing:

Block board and weave in all ends.
