### **Measuring Gauge (Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup>)**

Measuring your gauge is important when starting a knitted piece. Matching your gauge to what is recommended in the pattern ensures that your finished piece will match the intended size.

### **Blocking (Oct. 7<sup>th</sup>)**

Blocking is the important final step to finishing a knitted piece. This process smooths out those wrinkles and highlights the beauty of your knitting. We'll cover the two most common ways of blocking.

### **Three-Needle Bind-off (Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>)**

This form of bind-off is useful in many instances and is not as daunting as it sounds. Three needles? Oh, my! We'll show you how it's done.

### **Crochet 101 • Beginner's Level**

#### **Tuition: \$20**

### **Simple Cardigan**

#### **Tuition: \$60**

#### **Note: Pattern must be purchased**

This is a great intro to sweaters as well as cables. Two birds with one stone. Simple, yet interesting. This is a knitter's favorite and trust us, you'll want to wear this one ALL THE TIME! *Supplies:* US6 & US8 needles, aran weight yarn

Have the option of using either laceweight or fingering weight. *Supplies:* 800 yds of laceweight/1100 yds of fingering weight yarn, US5 24" circular, & stitch markers
